Report Cards and Parent-Teacher Conference Schedules

➤ **Report Cards** are being sent home today. The 2nd-8th grade teachers are again using *Easy Grade Pro* computer software. You may keep the grade portion of the Report Card. The yellow sheet that requires your signature must be handed back to your child's teacher. K-1st grade students will need to return their report card after it has been signed. Music/Band, PE, and Preschool report cards are only sent home twice a year. Each family is receiving one manila envelope containing Report Cards for all students in the family. Please return the family envelope and student Report Card envelope for next quarter.

➤ **Fitnessgram** is a fitness test that all 1st-8th grade students participated in during the 1st Quarter. This test measured your child's flexibility, aerobic capacity (grades 3rd-8th), muscular strength and muscular endurance. The results were calculated to determine if your child is in the *Healthy Fitness Zone* (HFZ). If your child exceeded the HFZ it will have a + sign, if your child met the HFZ it will have a √ and if they did not achieve the HFZ it will have a - sign. Feel free to call me with any questions or concerns. **PLEASE RETURN THE RESULTS WITH YOUR CHILD'S REPORT CARD SO WE CAN SEE THE PROGRESS AFTER THE STUDENTS ARE TESTED IN THE 4TH QUARTER.**
