Biannual Society Meeting

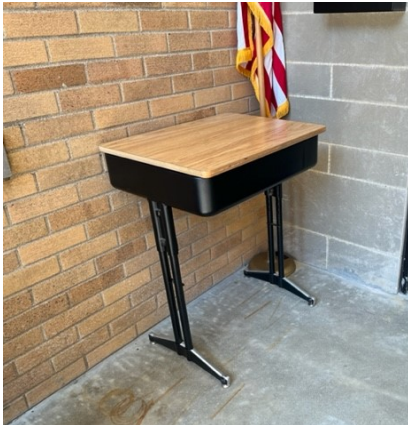
