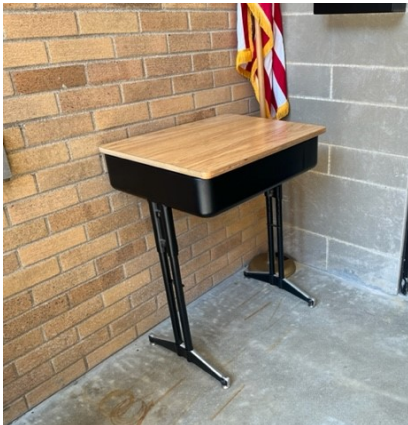
**Student Pictures** - Jill Christoffels will be taking student pictures on Thursday, September 15. Forms were sent home yesterday.
