Good Bye to Iowa Assessments and Welcome ISASP

Our students have been taking the Iowa Assessments (formally Iowa Test of Basic Skills) for many years. HCS uses the data, along with Aimsweb assessment, to assist in meeting the needs of our students and guide our teaching. After doing research, we have found a better assessment that will meet these needs. The students will no longer be taking the Iowa Assessments, but taking the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP.) The test will be given in the spring. More information about the specific week will be given later.
