Changes coming to the Box Tops for Education Program

The Box Top program is adopting new technology and moving the Box Tops program from physically cutting and collecting the Box Tops found on hundreds of products to accepting digital only collecting via receipts that you scan. What does this change mean for you? You will need to download the new user-friendly Box Tops for Education app, then set up an account and register the school you are going to support. This is a one time process, once you have your account set up and your school selected, you will be able to scan all future receipts and they will automatically add Box Tops for the school. You will be able to track earnings for Hull Christian from your smart phone. It should be noted that you need to scan your receipts soon after the purchase of the qualifying items so get in the habit of scanning right away!

Many of the products are already adapting this new digital process and you will see that the Box Tops logo on products look different, these are the products that you can only earn credit for if you get the app and register our school in the set up process. Please don't cut out the new logo, only the "old"/traditional type that include the date and product code. Eventually all the products will transition to this process but there are many that still have the traditional Box Tops that you clip, please send those in! As an added feature while the transition is occurring, you can both scan the receipt and get credit in the app for the traditional clips as well as turn them in to school to be counted and mailed. We are still able to continue to send in Box Tops until they expire, so please continue to keep a look out for those and turn them in promptly! We can't get credit for expired Box Tops.
