Winter Weather Reminder

Please make sure your child has warm enough clothes for recess. (snow pants, coat, boots, hat and gloves).

11. Cold Weather Gear

- a. If temperature feels like 30 degrees or below a winter coat, hat and gloves are required to cover exposed skin. A coat, hat and gloves will hang in the hallway to indicate this is required. It will be at the discretion of the teacher for 5th-8th grade students.
- b. Students in grades K-4 are required to have snow pants and boots during the winter season.
- c. If temperature feels like between 30-40 degrees, students are required to have a second layer such as a coat, jacket or sweatshirt. It will be at the discretion of the outside recess teacher for 5th-8th grade students.
