An important ESA deadline is quickly approaching. ESA participants must approve payment of tuition and fees within the Odyssey platform no later than **September 30, 2024.**

**ESA approved students who do not confirm payment of tuition and fees by the September 30, 2024 deadline will be deemed ineligible for the 2024-2025 academic school year and their ESA will be closed.**

## Important Information on Hot Lunch Prices

Students are required to take three components of the meal when they come through the lunch line. We were notified by state program officials that if a student comes back for seconds and takes 3 additional meal components, they must be charged for an adult meal (\$4.95). This also includes students who qualify for free or reduce hot lunch. Below is our current pricing of our hot lunch program.

Student meal - \$3.10

Adult meal - \$4.95
