Information Needed for the 2025-2026 School Year

1. All students entering 7th grade must have the Meningococcal vaccine and a Tdap booster **before the first day of school.** They cannot start school without those vaccines.
 - * Call your healthcare provider to ask if your child still needs to get these vaccines
 - * A great time to get these vaccines is when kids go in for wellness and sports physicals in the summer.
 - * To be valid for school, the meningococcal vaccine and Tdap booster must be given after the age of 10.
 - * Bring an updated Iowa Certificate of Immunization from your provider to school or have the clinic fax it to school at 888-990-0581.
2. Students entering 7th and 8th grades (25-26) who plan on participating in sports are required to have an Athletic Physical. Forms are located on the HCS website.
3. If your child has gotten any immunizations in the past year, please get an updated immunization form to the office by September 1, 2025. Our audit is early September.
4. Any student with a dietary need/restrictions **MUST** have a doctor's note and they need to visit with Mr. Ten Pas or Mindy Baccam before the first day of school.
5. If you have any questions, please contact Mr. Ten Pas.
6. Looking forward to seeing you in this coming school year. The start date is August 25, 2025.
