School Bus Service Policy Update

A new school bus service policy has been added to the Parent Handbook. Families who register for bus service are making a commitment for the full school year. If a family chooses to discontinue bus service, a prorated refund may be requested within the first 30 school days of the school year. Refunds will be prorated based on the date the school receives written notification of cancellation.

After the first 30 school days, bus service fees are nonrefundable. Families who begin attending HCS or request bus service later in the school year will have their fees prorated based on their start date, unless the request is made after the first 30 school days, in which case the full annual fee will apply. The Finance Committee may review unique circumstances on a case-by-case basis. Families are encouraged to review the complete policy in the Parent Handbook

Important Information on Hot Lunch Prices

Students are required to take three components of the meal when they come through the lunch line. We were notified by state program officials that if a student comes back for seconds and takes 3 additional meal components, they must be charged for an adult meal (\$4.97). This also includes students who qualify for free or reduced hot lunch. Below is our current pricing of our hot lunch program.

Student meal - \$3.15

Adult meal - \$5.15

Extra milk - \$.50

Bread - \$.25

Second entrée - \$1.55

Second full meal - \$5.15

Fast Bridge Testing

Students (K-8) will be completing the fall Fast Bridge testing September 1-11. Preschool will be doing Fast Bridge testing as well this year. They will be testing September 14-18. This is a screener we do three times a year (fall, winter, and spring) to see if students are meeting grade-level benchmarks in reading and math. Teachers will be in contact with you about your child's results.
