### **Construction News and Safety**

We are excited to share that construction on our new addition will be starting soon! As work begins, you will notice increased traffic on 5th Street. Construction equipment will be entering the school property from 5th Street, and a portion of the sidewalk will be blocked so equipment can safely access the construction site. As a result of construction activity and additional vehicles parked near the site, parking along this section of 5<sup>th</sup> Street will be limited for student pick-up.

Once construction begins, we will adjust our dismissal times slightly to help with traffic flow and student safety. All bus students will be dismissed at 3:22 p.m., and the remaining students will be dismissed at 3:25 p.m. This staggered dismissal will allow more families to use the church parking lot and will provide students with a safer walk through the parking lot area.

We will continue to monitor the crosswalk to help ensure student safety if families need to park in other areas. If your child walks to school, please take a moment to talk with them about the changes and consider using an alternate route if needed. Thank you for your patience and support as we begin this exciting project!
