Winter Weather Reminder

Please make sure your child has warm enough clothes for recess. (snow pants, coat, boots, hat and gloves).

11. Cold Weather Gear

- If temperature feels like 30 degrees or below a winter coat, hat and gloves are required to cover exposed skin. It will be at the discretion of the teacher for 5th-8th grade students.
- Students in grades K-5 are required to have snow pants and boots during the winter season.
- If temperature feels like between 30-40 degrees, students are required to have a second layer such as a coat, jacket or sweatshirt. It will be at the discretion of the outside recess teacher for 6th-8th grade students.

New Timpani

Recently, a new 32" timpani drum was purchased, bringing HCS to three timpani drums of different sizes. Timpani are tuned percussion instruments that change pitch using a foot pedal, and each drum can play a range of notes. With this new drum, students are able to play more notes and perform more challenging music. This beautiful instrument was purchased using funds from concert and program offerings, and we are very thankful for your generous support of music education at HCS.
