ESA Update – PARENTS MUST TAKE ACTION

Parents must take action in order to receive their second half payment for ESA funding. The process to approve your funding is very similar to the process you followed this fall. HCS will confirmed the amount and then parents must approve the payment through the Odyssey portal NO LATER THAN January 31, 2026.

FastBridge Testing

Students will be completing the winter FastBridge testing K-8th January 12-23 and Preschool is January 26-30. This is a screener we do three times a year (fall, winter, and spring) to see if students are meeting grade-level benchmarks in reading and math. Teachers will be in contact with you about your child's results.

Winter Weather Reminder

Please make sure your child has warm enough clothes for recess. (snow pants, coat, boots, hat and gloves).

11. Cold Weather Gear

- a. If temperature feels like 30 degrees or below a winter coat, hat and gloves are required to cover exposed skin. It will be at the discretion of the teacher for 5th-8th grade students.
- b. Students in grades K-5 are required to have snow pants and boots during the winter season.
- c. If temperature feels like between 30-40 degrees, students are required to have a second layer such as a coat, jacket or sweatshirt. It will be at the discretion of the outside recess teacher for 6th-8th grade students.
