Dress Warm Reminder

It is only October, but the cold air has arrived. If your child wears a cap and gloves to school, please have them labeled so they do not get lost. Please have them wear appropriate outdoor clothing so they are more "motivated" to go out to recess.

Just a reminder of our school policy

10. Cold Weather Gear

- If temperature feels like 30 degrees or below a winter coat, hat and gloves are required to cover exposed skin. A coat, hat and gloves will hang in the hallway to indicate this is required. It will be at the discretion of the teacher for 6th-8th grade students.
- Students in grades K-5 are required to have snow pants and boots during the winter season.
- If temperature feels like between 30-40 degrees, students are required to have a second layer such as a coat, jacket or sweatshirt. It will be at the discretion of the outside recess teacher for 6th-8th grade students.
