Mr. Minderhoud (Principal) – Academic oversight, student discipline, student support services, support programs and other day-to-day school operations.

Fast Bridge Testing

Students (K-8) will be completing the fall Fast Bridge testing September 8-18. Preschool will be doing Fast Bridge testing as well this year. They will be testing September 21-25. This is a screener we do three times a year (fall, winter, and spring) to see if students are meeting grade-level benchmarks in reading and math. Teachers will be in contact with you about your child's results.
