Important Information on Hot Lunch Prices

Students are required to take three components of the meal when they come through the lunch line. We were notified by state program officials that if a student comes back for seconds and takes 3 additional meal components, they must be charged for an adult meal (\$4.97). This also includes students who qualify for free or reduce hot lunch. Below is our current pricing of our hot lunch program.

Student meal - \$3.10

Adult meal - \$4.97

Extra milk - \$.50

Bread - \$.25

Second entrée - \$1.55

Second full meal - \$4.97

Fast Bridge Testing

Students (K-8) will be completing the fall Fast Bridge testing September 2-12. Preschool will be doing Fast Bridge testing as well this year. They will be testing September 15-19. This is a screener we do three times a year (fall, winter, and spring) to see if students are meeting grade-level benchmarks in reading and math. Teachers will be in contact with you about your child's results.
